Apparatus Designations and Classifications

1. **Brush Unit**
 - 4 wheel drive
 - 50 gallon water tank
 - 5 G.P.M. pump
 - Chainsaw
2. **TAC Unit**
 - 200 gallon water tank
 - 200 G.P.M. pump
 - 100 ft. of 3" supply line
 - 1 – 100 ft. of 1½" attack line pre-connect
 - 10 Ft. ladder
 - 2 – S.C.B.A.
3. **Engine**
 - 750 G.P.M. pump
 - 300 gallon water tank
 - 35 ft. of ground ladders
 - S.C.B.A.
 - 500 Ft. of 3" supply line
 - 2-150 ft. of 1½" attack line pre-connect
4. **Squirt**
 - 50 ft. aerial device
 - Meets engine classifications
 - Pre-piped waterway
5. **Ladder**
 - 50 ft. straight aerial device
 - 75 ft. of ground ladders
 - Generator
 - Salvage equipment – tarps, runners, buckets
 - Ventilation equipment-gas powered saw and fans
 - Ropes and riggings
 - Stokes basket
 - S.C.B.A.
6. **Tanker**
 - 2000 gallon or more water tank
 - 250 G.P.M. pump
 - 200 ft. of 3" supply line
7. **Tower**
 - 75 ft. aerial device with personnel bucket
 - 75 ft. of ground ladders
 - Generator
 - Salvage equipment – tarps, runners, buckets
 - Ventilation equipment-gas powered saw and fans
 - Ropes and riggings
 - Stokes basket
 - S.C.B.A.
8. **Squad**
 - Personnel Carrier
9. **Air Unit**
 - Air compressor for S.C.B.A.
 - Generator
 - 4000 watts of lights
10. **QRS**
 - Equipped for ALS/BLS support
 - Personnel carrier
11. **MICU**
 - ALS ambulance
 - Transport capable
12. **Traffic Unit**
 - Arrowstick or arrowboard
 - Cones/barricades
 - Line tape
 - Flashlights
 - Flares
 - Vests
 - Flares
13. **Utility**
 - Equipment or personnel carrier
14. **Pumper/Tanker**
 - Meets engine classifications
 - 2000 gallon water tank
